
Align the two large parts as shown. Leave 2 holes in the middle for the pipe clamp. If the bracket needs to be shorter then slide the brackets inward and align the holes until you get the length you need. If the holes in the brackets don't appear to line up, switch the top bracket to the bottom. They only line up one way.



Install the mounting pipe (not supplied) into one of the V bracket as shown.




Loosly fit the upper bracket to the pipe. You may have to move it during installation.



The bracket may installed from the roof top or from a ladder. Take precautions when installing the bracket as a fall from this height will cause serious injury or death. Center the bracket as shown on the eve of the roof top. Install the top bracket first using the lag screw supplied. Make sure the bottom bracket is where it needs be before securing the bolts. A small pilot hole in the eve where the bolts go will allow for easy installation if desired. Install the bottom bracket making sure that the pipe is vertical before securing the bolts.

WARNING

<u>**Do not**</u> install any mast or antenna close to power lines. Do not install the mast in any location that it could contact power lines if it were to fall. Use caution when working with tall mast as they may become unstable and hard to control. It is best to always have a friend to help when installing antennas or antenna masts.

Any evidence of alteration, erasure, or forgery shall be cause to void any and all warranty terms immediately.

hy-gain agrees to repair or replace at hy-gain's option without charge to the original owner any defective product under warranty, provided the product is returned postage prepaid to hy-gain.

Under no circumstances is hy-gain liable for consequential damages to person or property by the use of any hy-gain products.

Out-of-warranty Service: hy-gain will repair any out-of-warranty product provided the unit is shipped prepaid. All repaired units will be shipped COD to the owner. Repair charges will be added to the COD fee unless other arrangements are made.

This warranty is given in lieu of any other warranty expressed or implied.

hy-gain reserves the right to make changes or improvements in design or manufacture without incurring any obligation to install such changes upon any of the products previously manufactured.
